U.S. Navy Announces Cleveland on Blue Angels 2010 Schedule
Cleveland National Air Show readies for traditional Labor Day Weekend

LAS VEGAS (DEC. 7, 2009)—Cleveland is among 35 U.S. cities selected to host the U.S. Navy Blue Angels in 2010. The Navy's precision Jet Demonstration Team will headline the 2010 Cleveland National Air Show presented by Discount Drug Mart on Labor Day Weekend (September 4, 5 & 6) at Burke Lakefront Airport.

The U.S. Department of Defense announced the complete 2010 Blue Angels schedule today at the annual International Council of Air Shows convention in Las Vegas.

Each day the six "Blues" demonstration pilots will blaze across the Cleveland skies with a one hour choreographed presentation that includes the graceful aerobatics of the four-plane diamond formation, exciting high-energy opposing maneuvers by the two solo pilots and a gravity defying demonstration by the Blue Angles C-130 Hercules support aircraft.

The Cleveland National Air Show is a Labor Day Weekend family tradition and one of the largest annual events on the North Coast. "The Air Show is the affordable, local outing that is fun for everyone," said Air Show Executive Director Chuck Newcomb, "and it isn't just in the sky, as the Air Show will host a variety of interactive ground displays, kid-friendly activities, planes and more. Fans can tour unique aircraft, help pack a parachute, get a picture with a pilot or just enjoy the day-long festival of flying, food and outdoor fun."
