Cleveland on U.S. Navy Blue Angels 2012 Flight Plan

Advance pilots land Wednesday to prep for Labor Day Weekend show

CLEVELAND, OH (DEC. 13, 2011)—Two members of the U.S. Navy Blue Angels will be in Cleveland Wednesday in preparation for the 2012 Cleveland National Air Show presented by Discount Drug Mart on Labor Day Weekend (Sept. 1, 2 & 3) at Burke Lakefront Airport. Cleveland is among 35 U.S. cities selected to host the U.S. Navy Blue Angels in 2012.

Blue Angel #7 Lt. Mark Tedrow of Willow Grove, Pa., and Blue Angel #8 Lt. Cmdr. Todd Royles of Charleroi, Pa., will do a flyover of Burke Lakefront Airport in their F/A-18 Hornet aircraft and are expected to land at Burke Lakefront Airport at 9:40 a.m. Wednesday. The team members of the elite flying squadron make the advance visit to meet with air show officials and supporting organizations.

“We are delighted to host the U.S. Navy Blue Angels for their winter visit,” said Air Show Executive Director Chuck Newcomb. “This is an outstanding way to kick-off the Air Show season.”

Additional performers for the 2012 Cleveland National Air Show will start being announced in January. Additional military tactical demonstrations depend on the U.S. Department of Defense, which announces those schedules in the spring.
